The scholarships are an opportunity for international students wishing to study at Australia's number one-ranked young university but who need a pathway option and the additional support of UTS College.

Scholarship value

20% tuition fee scholarship towards your enrolled UTS undergraduate or postgraduate degree (maximum 4 years)

How to apply

- No need to apply separately for these scholarships, applications will be assessed when students lodge applications to study at UTS College.
- The conditional scholarship offer letter will be sent following the Letter of Offer from UTS College and UTS.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for the scholarships, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Remain an international student (not an Australian citizen, New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of Australia); and
- Be a citizen from Hong Kong SAR, Japan, Macau SAR (diploma only), South Korea, Taiwan, Mongolia (diploma only), Fiji (diploma only), New Caledonia (diploma only), Vanuatu (diploma only), Tahiti (diploma only) or a country in the Latin America, Africa, South Asia, or South East Asia region: and
- Commence full-time studies and on campus** at UTS; and
- Meet UTS admission criteria for the selected UTS undergraduate coursework program; and
- Successfully complete a UTS College Diploma and be admitted based on this qualification to UTS; and
- Commence studies in a UTS undergraduate degree in 2023, 2024 or 2025 that directly articulates from their UTS College Diploma course, and
 in the next available intake after completion of the candidate's Diploma; and

Must not:

- be studying a UTS online degree or distance mode degree; or
- be a recipient of other UTS International scholarships or grants or the UTS Alumni Advantage Program for the duration of this Scholarship; and
- be a government sponsored student.
