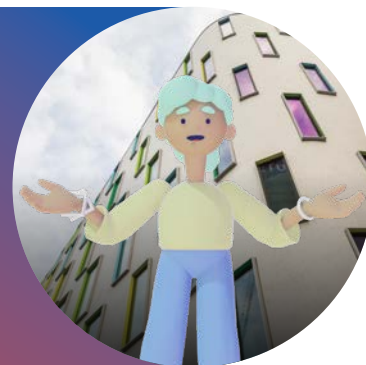

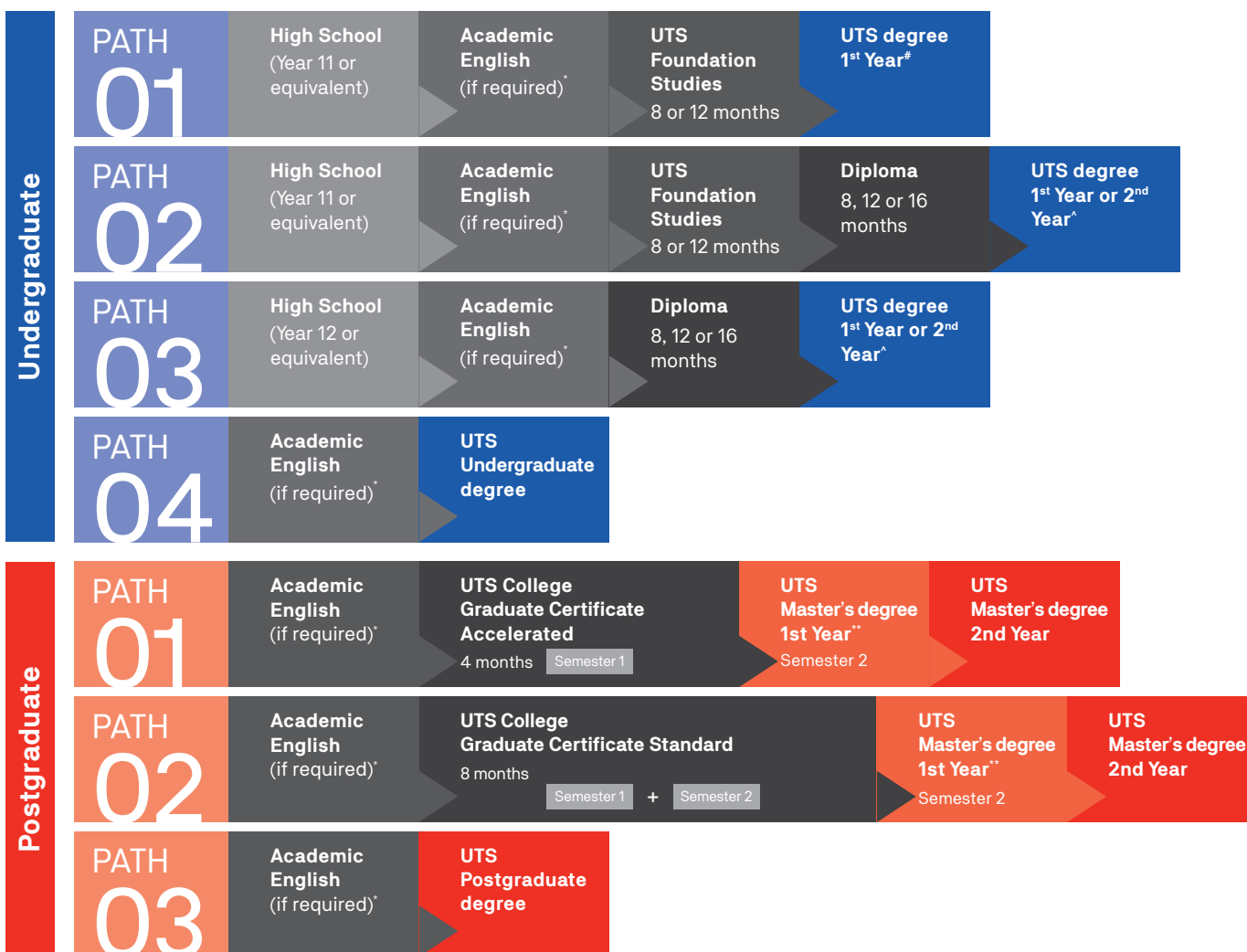

The fees are based on no subject failures. Any subject that needs to be undertaken a second time will require payment of the relevant subject fee.

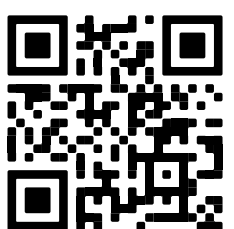
#### UTS College package discounts:
